 20 – 25 – 34 miles

**HELMETS

START: Burrillville High School, Rt 107, Burrillville MA

- 20 miles: Bear Right on Rt 100 after Pascoag, at junction with Buck Hill Rd.
- 25 miles: Continue Straight onto Rt 16 from Rt 12
- 34 miles: Follow solid outline.

SCENIC NOTES:

Enjoy a ride along wooded and lake-studded country roads where 3 states (RI, CT, MA) converge. Note the granite mills from the 1800's in Pascoag. Ride past Wilson Reservoir then climb Buck Hill to an altitude of 730 feet. Descend into lovely Thompson CT, known for a speedway racing track. Follow the shores of Lake Chargog....., then it's a smooth run into Sutton MA. Nice view from Sutton Falls, with one of the few covered bridges in south-central MA. Return by Manchaug Pond, Whitins Reservoir and the village of Douglas, with its stately white church, old cemetery and village green. Rt. 96 provides a nice run back to the start.
