## NARRAGANSETT INDIAN RIDE

15 & 26 mile rides

**START:** URI – West Independence Way parking lot,  
Rt. 138, Kingston, RI

15 miles: turn right at end of Wordens Pond Road.

26 miles: turn left at end of Wordens Pond Road

### SCENIC NOTES:

Enjoy this old favorite ride, which originated back in the 1980 Centennial Celebration. From URI, ride along Rt. 110 along Wordens Pond. The short ride turns right and heads towards the Kenyon Jonnycake mill. On the short ride return, a gravel road just before Liberty Lane will take you to the Great Swamp Fight monument dating back to the mid 1700's. The long ride passes by the Royal Indian Burial Grounds just off Narrow Lane. At the end of Narrow Lane, take the dirt road that goes by the Narragansett Indian Church. Rejoin the ride at Old Mill Rd.
