**START:** SALT POND SHOPPING CENTER  
Rt. 108, S. of Rt. 1, Narragansett

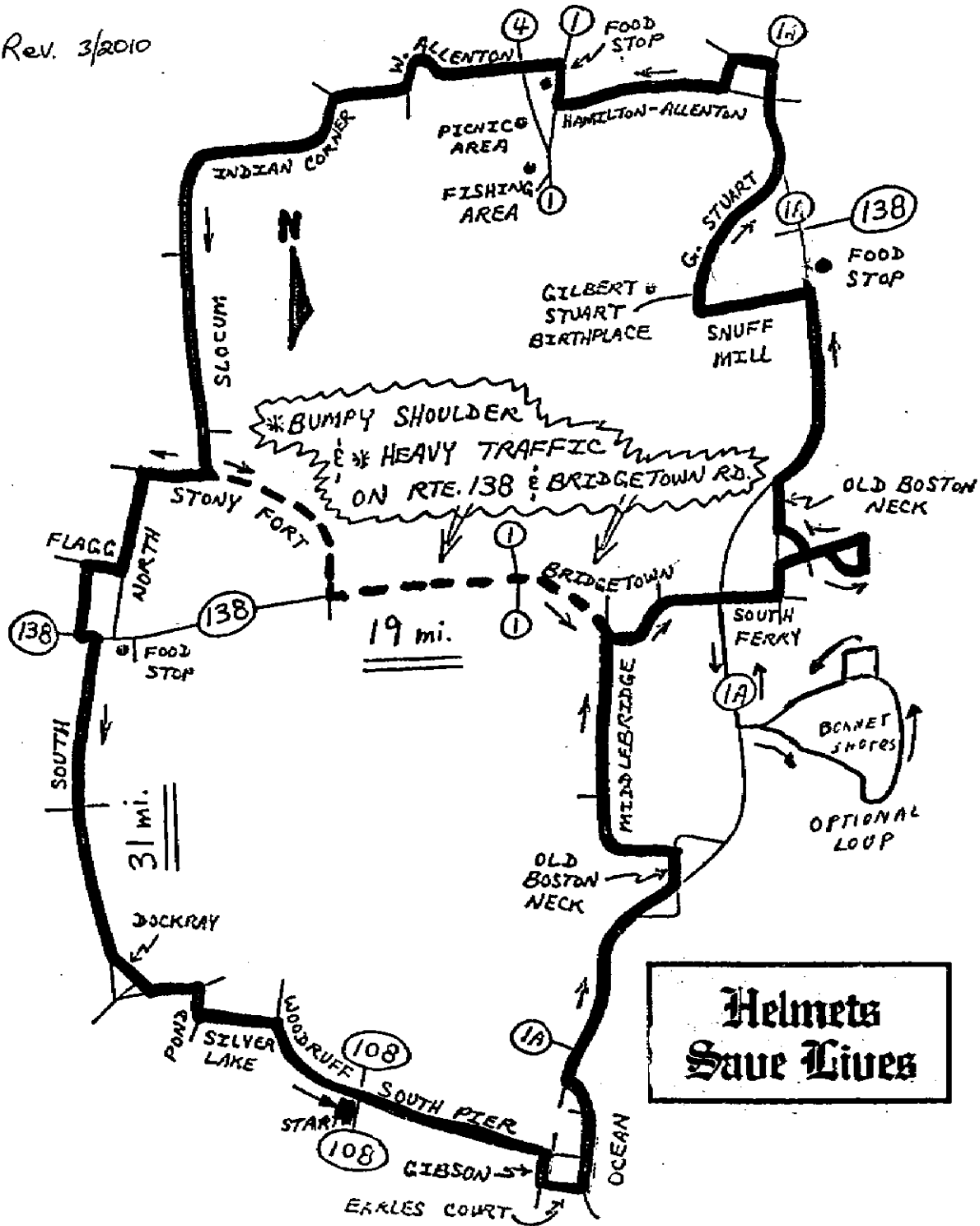
15 miles: SALT POND start; left at Middlebridge & Bridgetown, straight at Stony Fort & Slocum. Do lower loop only.

2. Gilbert Stuart birthplace, (foremost George Washington portraitist.)
3. Casey Farm (Preservation of N.E. Antiquities)
4. Bonnet Shores (optional loop, 4 miles)
5. Snuff Mill (first in America (circa 1751))
6. Food stops as shown on map.
