CUMBERLAND - WRENTHAM - PLAINVILLE

DIAMOND HILL RIDE #2, 17 - 30 - & 50 miles rides

START: Diamond Hill State Park, Rt. 114, Cumberland, RI

17 miles: Right at end of Bow St. onto Rhodes

30 miles: Left on Rhodes

50 miles: Left onto Taunton from George

SCENIC NOTES

This ride starts at Diamond Hill State Park (formerly the ski area) with its veined 200 foot quartz cliff. The ride passes by Sneeck Pond, open farmlands and scenic vistas. In Wrentham, note the white church past the Sheldonville food stop. In Plainville, enjoy the swooping downhill run along High St.

At the top of the ride is the WW I Memorial park with a small zoo and magnificent views from the fire tower. On the way back, enjoy the views along the Diamond Hill Reservoir then stop for ice cream right across from the park
